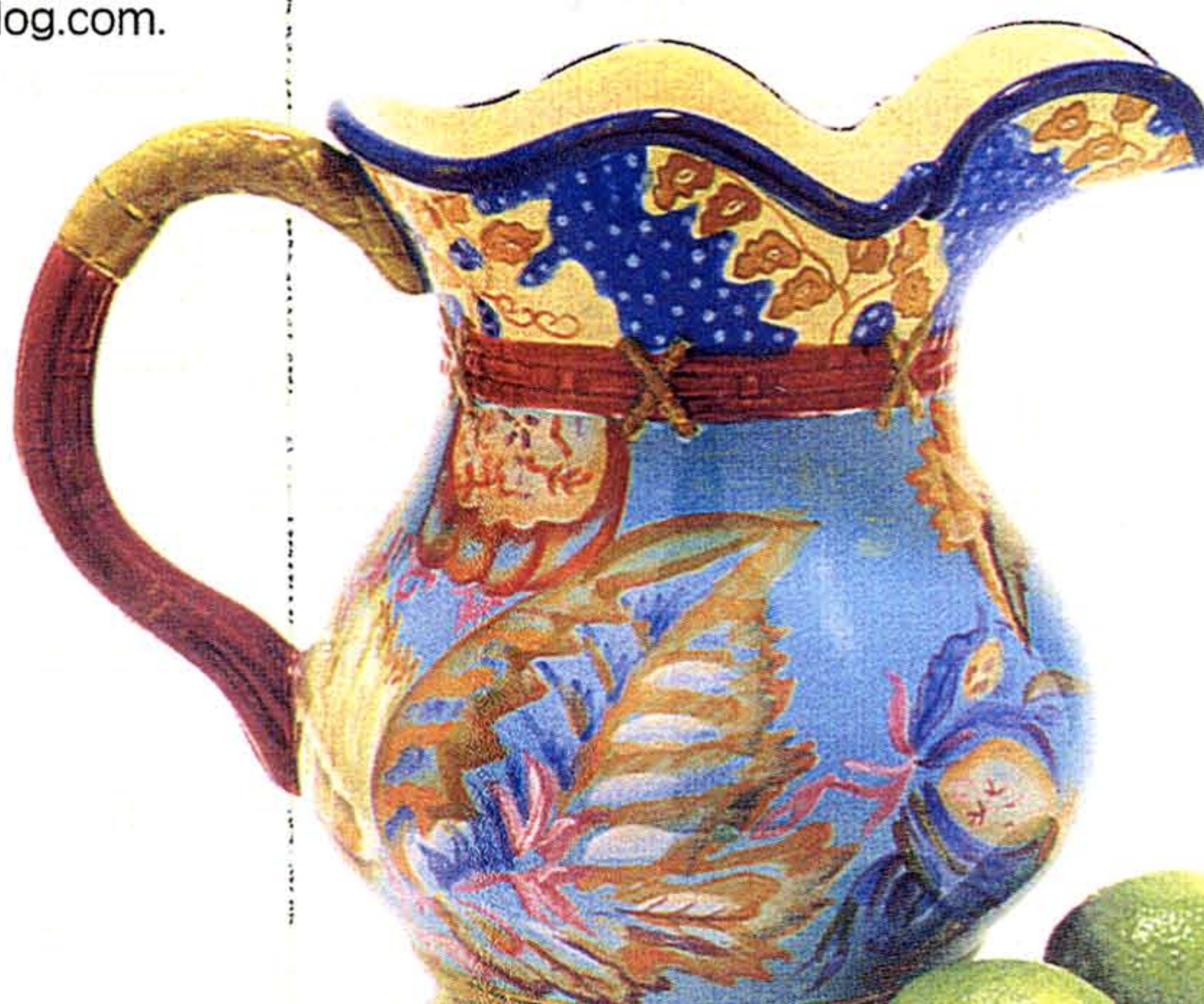


## Splurge of the Month
